Dear Racer,

The 2014 1/10th Electric Off Road Nationals will be held over 4 rounds with the best 3 to count. We are using three venues around Ireland and are hoping for an exciting championship.

To enter the championship at any time you must first join the RCCAOI and also submit the entry form at the end of this document. The RCCAOI form is available on the association website and may be submitted with your membership fee to the Treasurer. You may also give it to the 1/10th rep before racing at the first round you attend. Please note: if you have not joined the association and paid in full you will not be permitted to race.

Classes

Modified: As per RCCAOI rules, there is no motor limit or limit on timing. All motors must conform to EFRA motor specifications.

Clubman: As per RCCAOI rules, there is a limit of 10.5T motors and no timing or boost allowed on the ESC. This must be demonstrated by the driver with “blinky” mode or in the case of older ESCs, the programming box/computer. There will be scrutiny at each meeting.

There will be both Modified and Clubman for 2WD and 4WD.
